Private wildlife and hunting property with Yellowstone River frontage



There is a broad cross section of wildlife in this area: whitetail deer, mule deer, pronghorn antelope, fox, coyotes, bobcats, mountain lions, racoon, pheasant, sharp tail grouse, ducks, and geese, to name a few. There is excellent fishing and boating in the Yellowstone River.

This is a property which provides a lot of privacy. There are a number of great home sites. There are power and water wells in the area. The irrigated farmland has had excellent yields of corn, beets, and hay over the years.
